Contract Changes Crisis - Featured in Cumberland News

The Cumberland News have featured an article outlining the problems that face DeafVision. The article points out that DeafVision may have to make drastic cuts to its 40-strong workforce if it continues to lose out on work to large national organisations.

The county council's adult social care directorate now works to EU procurement laws in that any large contract – in this case, three-year contracts for "personal services" worth £157,000 or more – be put out to tender.
